We had $\frac{1}{2}$ a Celeriac, some Onions and a couple of rather sad Carrots. It's amazing what you can create **(Or more specifically Sue can invent)** from next to nothing. We've had similar versions on several occasions but today's was the best so far. It knocks the spots of shop bought Coleslaw.

Ingredients:-

Onions, Celeriac, Carrot. All finely sliced in roughly equal proportions

A dash of White Wine Vinegar

The juice of $\frac{1}{2}$ a Lemon

Fresh chopped Parsley (Just for a bit of colour)

Mayonnaise

Method:-

(1) As simple as mixing everything together and serving really.

The crunch of the Celeriac and the sharpness of the Vinegar and Lemon really work well together.
